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Benefits for Students & Families

- ▶ Instructors trained in dyslexia, dyscalculia, ELD, & special needs
- ▶ In-Person support with online schoolwork for students at a 3:1 ratio (Key Teams)
- ▶ Meal plans provided with no additional cost
- ▶ G4G seeking donations and grants to subsidize program expense to families
- ▶ Creating learning labs in the outdoor settings of the students' local parks
- ▶ Providing families with progress reports for each student every other week
- ▶ Speaking with Key Counselors and Learning Lab Instructors about student progress during morning drop offs and afternoon pick ups
- ▶ Families may adjust how their hours are used due to changes at their school site
- ▶ Keeping the price points down so all families can participate in the program over long durations of time, if necessary
- ▶ Offering instructional supervision inside and outside the home so parents can focus on their work responsibilities and/or time to secure new employment
